RSS Feeds and Podcasts

The White House RSS feed for President George W. Bush delivers headlines and links to White House news releases on www.whitehouse.gov/news, including events, speeches, statements, and press briefings from administration officials. In addition to the RSS feed, audio files of the President's Weekly Radio Address and selected remarks are available via Podcast.

RSS is an acronym for Really Simple Syndication or Rich Site Summary. It is an XML-based method for distributing the latest news and information from a website that can be easily read by a variety of news readers or aggregators. 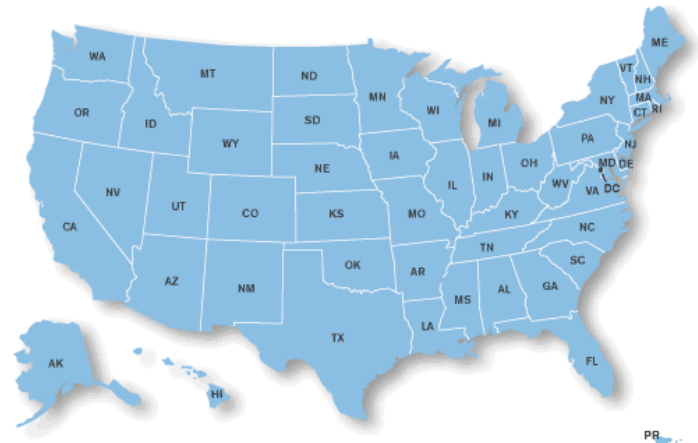
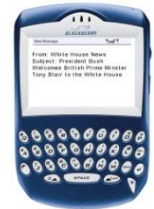

Rep. John Culberson (R-TX) is on Twitter @johnculberson. So is Rep. Tim Ryan (D-OH) @timryan. For those who don't know, Twitter is a microblog that enables users to "tweet" out short text messages in 140 characters or less (about a sentence or two) designed to answer this question: "What are you doing right now?"

The popularity of the site has certainly grown, especially in the world of politics in recent months:

- The White House has been on Twitter for about a year.
- Many presidential hopefuls were Twittering early in the 2008 campaign including Sens. Edwards, Obama, Clinton and McCain.
- At the Personal Democracy Forum (PdF) on June 23-24 in New York, Ana Marie Cox moderated a policy debate between Liz Mair (for McCain) and Mike Nelson (for Obama) via Twitter (hashtag: #PdF08)
